#### **Principal's Message**

What a year! It was lovely to be able to come together in the presentation assemblies for the first time since term 1. I would like to congratulate the students who were recognised with awards at the Presentation Assemblies. I was so impressed by the students good spirits and happiness for their peers. It was very strange to have the assemblies with no parents and also with no singing. The videos of the two presentation assemblies will be uploaded on to the school website next week and alerts will be sent home on Skoolbag.

The P&C met this week. One of the points of discussion was the Cooler Classrooms application for air-conditioning. As the results of the delay in the process and possible long delays in actual installation under this program, the P&C has decided to proceed independently of this grant. They will provide funds to allow for 6 air-conditioners to be installed. Having reviewed our school funds, we will be able to use money earnt from leasing of the canteen and school spaces to fund the installation in the remaining classrooms. I will work with our Assets Directorate to start the process and this will be completed hopefully in term 1 2021.

This term the teachers have been collating and analysing school data from a broad range of sources to determine areas for our 2021–2024 School Improvement Plan. The general focuses for the plan will be:

- Reading and maths
- Strengthening assessment and data analysis to ensure deep learning for all students
- Challenging all students and implementation of the Gifted and High potential policy
- Further growing innovative practices used in the school (sadly many that have not continued this year due to COVID restrictions) with a focus on developing student voice and their capacity in meta-cognition (being able to reflect on and articulate their thinking from their learning) and reasoning.

Finally I wish to thank all students, staff and parents. It has been a privilege to lead the school for the past 8 years and it will be very strange not returning in semester 1 next year. A parent who recently came up to enrol their child commented to someone in the department that coming here was 'like being wrapped in a warm hug'. I take great pride in our achievements academically and the improvements and initiatives we have delivered to improve our school site. However, it is the culture of the school, the care the teachers show to all students and the welcoming nature that students have that is so notable. I know that Ms Cidem will enjoy her time here and be welcomed warmly.

I hope you and your family have a safe and happy School break and Happy summer reading.


