Term 2 Update

Dear parents and carers

It was wonderful to welcome our students back to school today.

In line with some recent announcements around COVID-19, I would like to outline some school guidelines.

Household Contacts

In line with the new regulations regarding household contacts, students no longer need to isolate at home if someone in their household tests positive to COVID-19. Further information can be found here and is also summarised for you below:

- Must call or email to notify the school that he/she is a household contact
- No need to self-isolate unless symptoms present
- If symptoms develop, stay home and get tested
- Attendance at school permitted (unless symptoms present)
- Daily rapid antigen surveillance testing is encouraged for 5 days. If negative, students may attend school

Positive Cases

If a rapid antigen test is positive your child should isolate as someone who has tested positive to COVID-19. You must also register any positive test on the Service NSW website so you can be linked to important health care support and advice. *Please let the school know immediately if your child has tested positive for COVID-19.*



You can use this decision tree that may assist you before considering whether to send your child to school or to isolate.

RAT Kits

Additional RATs will be given to students today to assist families with daily testing requirements for close contacts.
