


**COVID-19 Return to Learning from Home**

## Dear Parents/Carers

As you are no doubt aware the NSW Premier has announced an extension to the current stay-at-home orders until midnight Friday 16 July 2021. Confirmation has also been provided that schools in Greater Sydney will be learning from home during this time. NSW Health has introduced a four-tier system to provide clarity around the restrictions that apply to schools; Week 1 Term 3 will take place under Level 4 restrictions.

At Concord West Public School, our staff have been working hard to ensure continuity of learning for our students and we are ready to commence learning from home from Tuesday 13 July 2021. If you intend to send your child to school next week, please complete this <u>form</u> by Monday 12 July so that attendance can be tracked, and appropriate supervision organised.

I want to reassure you once again that the health and safety of our community is our top priority while also ensuring quality teaching, learning and support.

As was the case in 2020, the guidelines around these restrictions are unpredictable and rapidly changing. I will update all families with further information as they arise. Please ensure that you have access to Skoolbag and your emails as we will be updating you via these platforms.
