Description:	Water safety and swimming are an important skill and a learning goal of the Physical Education syllabus. Our annual Intensive Swimming program has been organised. All classes K-6, and all levels of ability, will be catered for in 10 lessons of 35 minutes each. Children will be assessed and grouped, from water awareness and beginners to stroke correction and squad level. Instruction is by qualified instructors employed by the Aquatic Centre. Travel will be by bus. Years K-6 teachers will attend and supervise the children. We encourage all parents to support the school in this activity, it is anticipated that all children will take part. As the instructors and buses will be booked for the full ten days there can be no refunds for missed lessons. The cost includes pool entry, instructors, transport, a swimming cap and a certificate at the end of the program. Please speak to the Office if you require assistance to pay. Students without a permission note will not be able to attend.

Information for parents/caregivers

- Children arrive at school dressed in school uniform.
- Each child will bring a plastic or swimming bag with child's name on it containing
 - 1. swimming costume (clearly labelled)
 - 2. towel (clearly labelled)
 - 3. goggles (clearly labelled)
 - 4. thongs, sandals or crocs
- If your child can't go in the water one day, **you must send a note** to the class teacher explaining. They may still go to the pool to observe. Children with no note will automatically go to the pool to observe or will be lent a costume and towel.
- If children forget costumes or towels we try to lend them some of the spares we have. Do you have any that your child doesn't fit into? Please wash and send to school.
- Children are tested and grouped on the first day. They will be issued with a swimming cap which remains at school until the last day.
- There is no refund for missed lessons.
- Parents may choose to attend the swimming centre but must pay an entry fee and make their own travel arrangements.
- Classes will be supervised when changing, in preparation for swimming and on their return.
- Any supervised lunch and recess time missed, will be given when students return from the pool.
