Term 3 Learning Overview

English

This term students are learning about writing poetry. They will engage in using a variety of poetic devices, such as metaphors and alliteration to create interesting poems. Each class engages in a unique reading program which focuses on learning and improving on both literal and inferential comprehension strategies. Students are afforded many opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills within small group and whole class activities.

Maths

Students are learning to develop their mathematical thinking by engaging in a variety of maths tasks each week. We will focus on thinking flexibly with numbers and using a range of strategies to solve problems. Students are encouraged to justify their answers.

Other Key Learning Areas

Science: Stage 2 of the Physical World strand focuses on light, heat and electrical energy and how contact forces affect the behaviour of objects. It helps develop students' understanding of energy as a resource that can be generated and transferred. Stage 2 will investigate the relationship between energy and forces that affect the behaviour of objects. Students will observe how energy and forces are used in the manufacture of products.

Creative Arts: Students will work with specialist art teacher Signora Mazzeo to appreciate and produce art work inspired by learning from our science unit. They will also participate in music lessons with specialist music teacher Mr Wallace.

Personal Development: Students will learn about skills and strategies we need to be safe, empowered and healthy. They will also be investigating strategies to enhance our own and others well-being and participation in physical activity.

Physical Education: Students will participate in PSSA or school sport program, including basketball and soccer lessons. They will participate in a wide variety of physical activities to apply, refine and adapt movement skills.
